THE CAHANA SISTERS is a thoughtful, deftly shot documentary about four sisters who survived the camps. Gilad Melzer's unique portrait illuminates their dramatic life journeys and documents a rare example of four siblings who survived together. The film presents the personal stories and memories of each one of the sisters, whose narratives many times contradict and collide with one another. Their meetings—emotionally charged and often entertaining—enable them for the first time to expose their innermost feelings and to frankly discuss their complex and entangled relationships. What is most unusual and fascinating is how their memories of their experience in the camps differ and how they reconcile those differences decades after their liberation.
