*A Polish Jew born in what is now White Russia, at the age of eighteen Mira Shelub joined a partisan group that operated in the forest near her native Zdziedciol. With her family, she escaped Zdziedciol's ghetto in 1942 as the Germans began killing off the population. Mira recounts "in the frost we did not only fight a physical battle, but also a spiritual battle. We were sitting around the fire, singing songs together, supporting each other and dreaming about better days and a better future... a better tomorrow."*
